Attention Federal Employees

Federal employees perform critical work in support of our Nation, including, at times, making the ultimate sacrifice, losing their lives in serving the public. To recognize these employees, Congress enacted the Civilian Service Recognition Act of 2011 (Public Law 112-73) on December 20, 2011. This law authorizes the presentation of a United States flag to a family member or other appropriate representative of a fallen Federal employee as a way for our Nation to express our deepest gratitude and sympathy.

WEINGARTEN RIGHT. Under § 7114(a)(2)(B), an employee being examined in an investigation (an investigatory examination or interview) is entitled to union representation if:

1. the examination is conducted by a representative of the agency;
2. the employee reasonably believes that the examination may result in disciplinary action;
3. and the employee asks for representation.

The availability encompasses more than \$25 million of work, making it one of largest work packages conducted by the command on an Arleigh Burke-class guided missile destroyer.
- Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility recently completed a six-month 63,500 man-day dry-docking selected restricted availability on USS Santa Fe (SSN 763) on schedule and within budget.

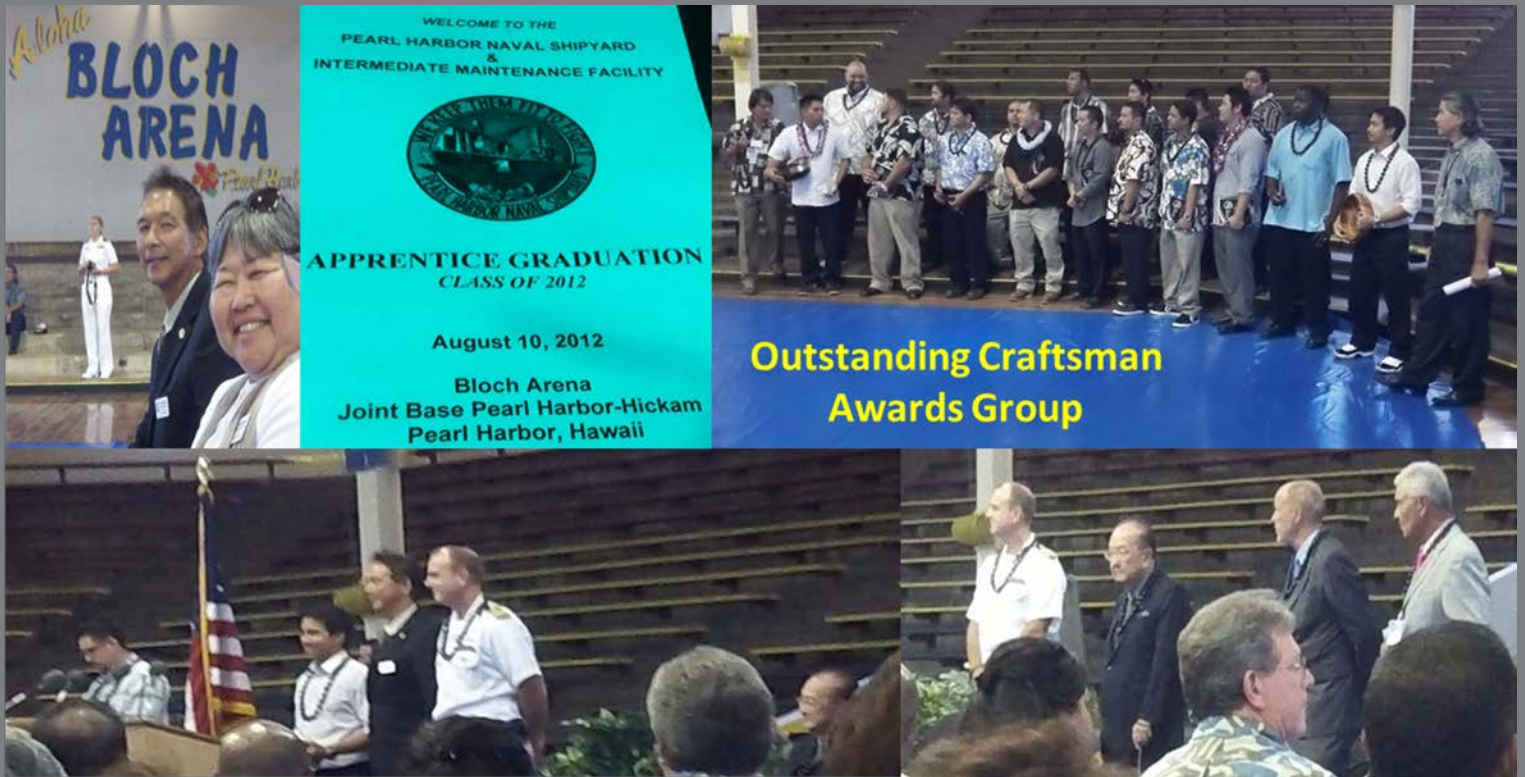

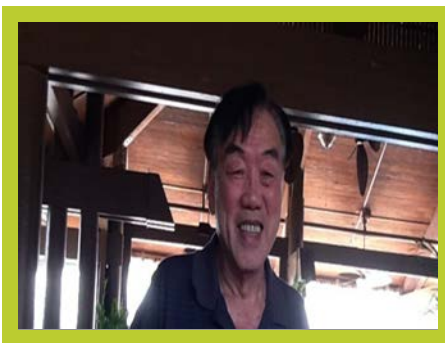
